

# Iguazú

The waterfalls from Iguazú are the biggest waterfalls of South-America and they are situated on the border of Argentina and Brazil. It is a set of 270 to 300 waterfalls and these are located in 2 National Parks: National Park Iguazú in Argentina and National Park Iguazu in Brazil. The most famous part of these waterfalls is 'Garganta de Diablo' that means 'the Throat of the Devil'. This is a large semicircular waterfall of 150 meters wide and goes up to 70 meters deep. Right there in the middle is the border of Argentina and Brazil. You can visit both sides to have different views of the whole complex.

## Day 1

- 13.10 Flight from Aeroparque Jorge Newbery to Cataratas del Iguazú International Airport.
- 14.05 Arrival at Iguazu Airport. You can take a taxi to the hotel or you can arrange a transfer at one of the companies at the airport.
- 15.00 Check-in in hotel Jardin Iguazú.
- 17.00 You can discover the small center of this town.
- 18.00 Refresh yourself for dinner and relax a little bit.
- 19.30 In the town you can choose between different restaurants to eat dinner. A couple of good restaurants are Color Parrilla, Aqva and A Piacere. These restaurants are situated in Avenida Córdoba.

## Day 2

- 7.00 Breakfast at the hotel.
- 7.45 Departure to Iguazu waterfalls at the Argentinian side.
- 8.30 Arrival at the waterfalls. You can follow the green path to 'the Throat of the Devil'. You can choose to walk or to take the small train from the park.
- 9.00 Walk above the water to the big waterfall. Once you are at the waterfall you are going to get wet because of the mist that comes up due to the amount of water that's falling down.
- 12.00 You go back with the small train to a place in the park with a couple of restaurants where you can have lunch.



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- 13.30 You can do a boat tour so you are really next to the falls. During this tour you get a nice view of the falls and you also get a kind of a shower because you go through the waterfalls.
- 15.00 End of the boat tour. After this you walk at the lower trail and by this you get again a different view of the falls.
- 16.00 Departure to the hotel.
- 17.00 Arrival at the hotel. You can relax.
- 19.00 You can choose again where you are going to have dinner.

### Day 3

- 8.00 Breakfast at the hotel.
- 8.45 Departure to the waterfalls at the Brazilian side.
- 10.00 Arrival to the waterfalls. Here you take a bus from the park to the start of the walk for the view of the waterfalls. During this walk you get different views and in the end you can take the panoramic elevator to get a view over the whole area. It is possible to eat something in a restaurant from the park.
- 14.00 Departure back to the hotel. Time to relax.
- 16.00 About a 25-minute walk lies the 3-country point. From here you can see Brazil and Paraguay with just a river between.
- 18.00 Walk back to the center en there you can choose again a restaurant to have dinner.

### Day 4

- 9.00 Breakfast at the hotel.
- 10.00 You can make your suitcase before leaving back to Buenos Aires.
- 11.15 Departure to Iguazu Airport.



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

- 13.45 Departure to Aeroparque Jorge Newbery.
